Order of Youth Service

10:45 am—11:00 am Gathering Activity

This is a time of gathering together and connecting. Informal, creative activities are offered, themed to the lesson of the day.

11:00 am—11:15 Opening Circle

We begin with lighting the Christ Candle to center ourselves, and focus our consciousness on the God Light that dwells within us all. Song, meditation, prayers and thanksgivings are all components of the Opening Circle. A love offering is accepted in order to help our youth understand the circle of giving and receiving.

11:15 am —11:45 am Lesson + Creative Expression

Each Sunday lesson focuses on a specific topic relating to spiritual growth. The experience is geared to stimulate individual thought and group discussion. We engage our youth in an exploration of the topic, and how it reflects Unity principles in their daily lives. Creative expression offers an experiential understanding of each lesson principle. These activities include art, games, music and craft projects. Group discussions invite our youth to explore what the ideas shared mean to them, personally.

11:45 am —11:55 am Closing Activity

During this time, we wrap up the day's activities and lovingly prepare classroom space for the next week. We look ahead into the coming week and anticipate how we will carry forward our new understanding of the lesson themes.

11:55 am —Youth Join Adult Service

Before rejoining their families, youth congregants join the adult service in the sanctuary for closing celebration and blessing. Services conclude as a combined congregation.

- You have ample time to get acquainted with our Youth Ministry.



Sacred Safety: We strive to provide a safe and nurturing environment for ALL at Unity. Youth have 3 opportunities to make choices that are safe & respectful for everyone. When needed

- 1. We ask that they redirect and make a safe/respectful choice.
- 2. We will place the child in a time-out if a safe choice is not made.
- 3. We will remove the child from the youth area, and they will be returned to your care.

Note: We have an "open door" policy: You are welcome to remain in the Nursery or Youth areas for as long as you wish and/or visit at any time.
